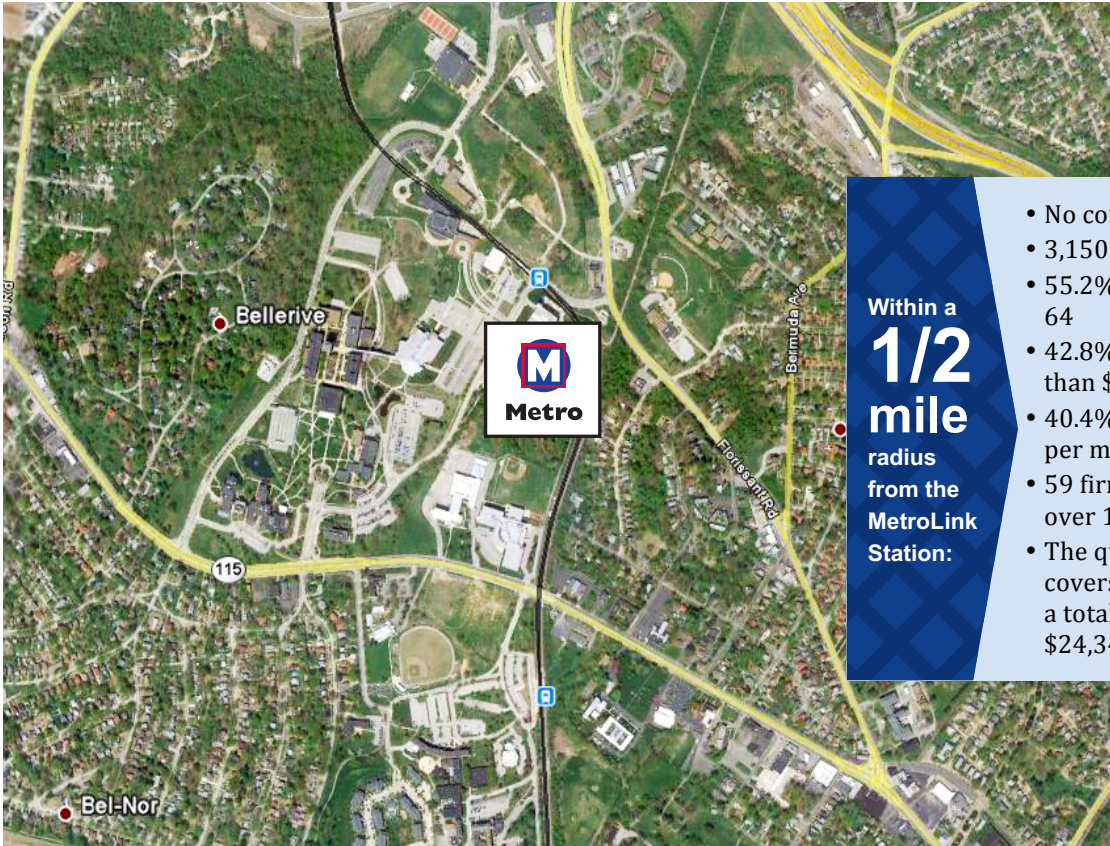




# UMSL – North Station

- The quarter-mile station area covers 130 lots on 11 blocks, with a total assessed value of \$24,340,180.

The UMSL North Station directly serves the University of Missouri – St. Louis’ North Campus, as well as surrounding parts of the City of Normandy. Florissant Road is a major north-south thoroughfare running through the quarter-mile station area, and the I-70 corridor is just north of the UMSL campus. UMSL’s North Campus occupies most of quarter-mile station area. The area east of Florissant Road, across from UMSL’s campus, is largely a residential area developed with two- and three-story garden apartments complexes and student housing, though there are also one- and two-story single-family homes around the periphery of the station area.

There is also a large vacant lot directly north of the MetroLink Station, adjacent to UMSL’s campus.

*There is no Park-Ride Lot at this station.*
